1906

CB founded in San Francisco by Colbert Coldwell as Tucker, Lynch & Colbert.

1970

Ikoma Corp (now CBRE K.K.) founded in Osaka, Japan.

1971

Ikoma Corp opened Tokyo Branch. Coldwell Banker is listed for the first time on the New York Stock Exchange.

1987

Ikoma Data Service System (now CBRE K.K.) founded.

1989

Ikoma TBM (now CBRE K.K.) founded.

1990

Ikoma America founded in New York.

1991

Company changes name to CB Commercial.

1995

CB Commercial acquires Westmark Realty Advisors (now CBRE Global Investors).

1998

Nippon FM Agency System (now CBRE K.K.) founded.

CB Commercial acquires REI Limited, creating a global platform, and subsequently changes company name to CB Richard Ellis (now CBRE).

1999

CBRE forms a capital alliance with Ikoma Corp. Ikoma CB Richard Ellis changes company name to CB Richard Ellis KK.

2003

CB Richard Ellis merges with Insignia/ESG. CBRE becomes the world's real estate service leader.

2004

CB Richard Ellis Group, Inc. (now CBRE Group) begins trading its class A Common Stock on the New York Stock Exchange.

2005

CB Richard Ellis Group, Inc. debuts on the Fortune 1000 list.

2006

CB Richard Ellis Group, Inc. named to S&P 500. Acquisition of Trammell Crow Company.

2007

CB Richard Ellis Group, Inc. named one of Fortune's 100 Fastest Growing Companies.

2008

CB Richard Ellis Group, Inc. becomes first commercial real estate service provider included in the Fortune 500. Ranked #11 in the BusinessWeek 50 list of the best-in-class companies across all industries.

2010

CB Richard Ellis Group, Inc. gains 100% full ownership of its Japanese businesses.

2012

CB Richard Ellis Group, Inc. changes name to CBRE. CB Richard Ellis KK. changes company name to CBRE KK.

2015

CBRE acquired Global Workplace Solutions business from Johnson Controls, becoming one of the world's largest providers of Facilities Management services.
